



College and University Grant Scoring System

The North Carolina Problem Gambling Program (NCPGP) grant application scoring system uses a 25-point scale for the grant review process. The 25-point impact activity score includes: outreach and education, screening and policy implementation. Not all college and universities will receive the same amount of funding nor are guaranteed funding each year. Past grant performance will also be taken into consideration by reviewing outcome reports.

Impact Activity Score

| Impact Activity | Score |

| Create and release an educational marketing campaign utilizing the NCPGP Helpline | 4 points |
| Create and implement an educational problem gambling event led by peer educators and staff who have attended Sure Bet training | 4 points |
| Create and infuse problem gambling education into curriculum in psychology, social work or counseling courses | 4 points |
| Send out press releases, social media posts or adding content to electronic or print media | 2 points |
| Participate in National Gambling Disorder Screening Day or offer screening on another day that suits the college calendar | 2 points |
| Send counselors, staff or faculty to Sure Bet workshops | 2 points |
| Have a counseling staff member who has attended both Sure Bet One and Sure Bet Two | 1 point |
| Create a gambling policy or have a current gambling policy | 1 point |
| Send peer educators to Sure Bet workshops | 1 point |
| Peer educators give presentations on campus regarding problem gambling to peers after attending Sure Bet workshops | 1 point |
| Add screening questions to counseling center, health center or financial aid departments with clear action plan on how to refer students to treatment services | 1 point |
| Promote the NCPGP Helpline by distributing promotional items or brochures at events | 1 point |
| Integrate problem gambling into Collegiate Recovery Program or other health and wellness coalitions on campus | 1 point |

Total Points and Funding

| 1-2 points | Up to \$1,000 |
| 3-4 points | Up to \$2,000 |
| 5 + points | Up to \$5,000 |
